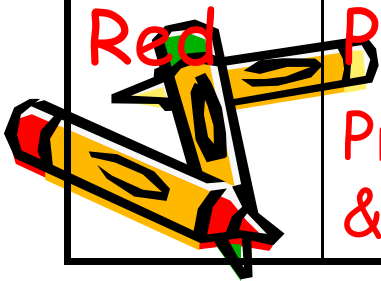
Folders, Folders, Folders

We have three folders that go home weekly with your child. The folder schedule is as follows:



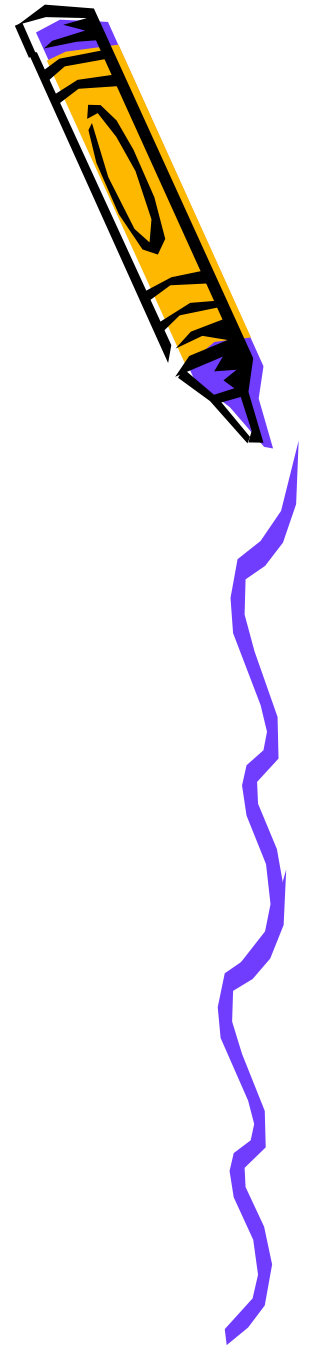
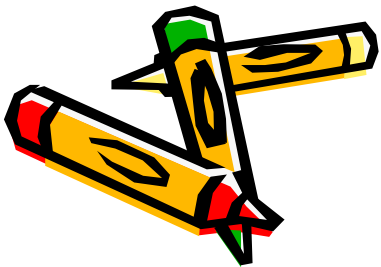
Green	Communication: Behavior, notes, newsletters & office paperwork	Everyday 😊

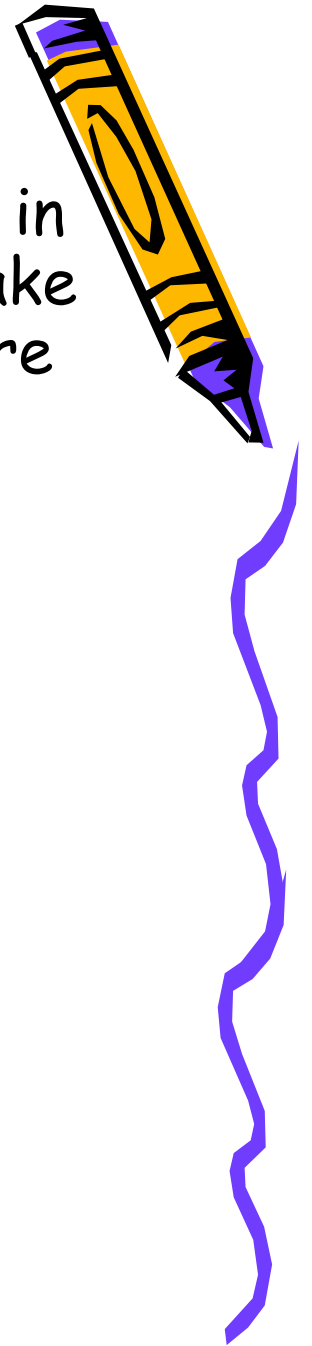
Wish List

- Clorox wipes

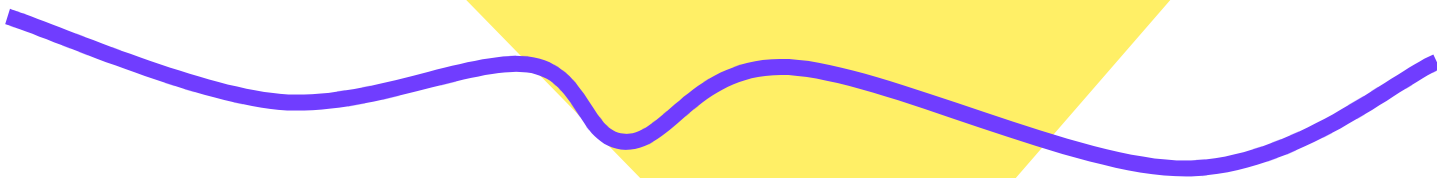

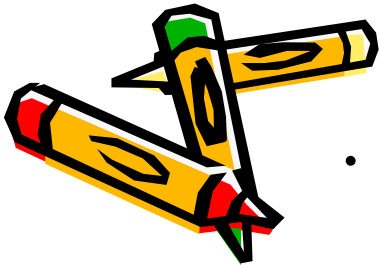
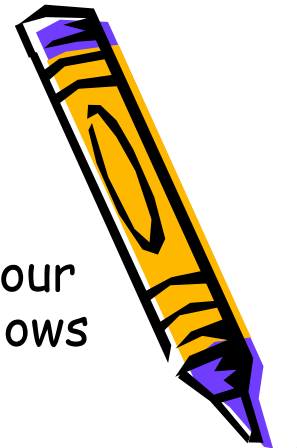
