They will need to know all of them OUT OF ORDER and write the numeral correctly!**

Please remember if your child doesn't know their sight words, they are struggling with their journal writing and reading. Your child should be starting to write at least one sentence using beginning and ending sounds and sight words! Don't forget capital at the beginning and period at the end!
