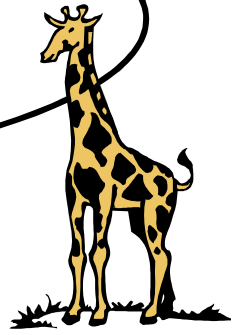

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What will my child learn in kinder? (Expectations)

- Name/Identify all upper and lowercase letters
- Produce all letter sounds
- Learn over 60 sight words
- Write sentences and small stories
- Read books at minimum "C" reading level
- Produce rhyming words
- Blend sounds
- Count to 100 by 1, 2's, 5's & 10's
- Identify numbers 0-31
- Subitize
- Learn to join and separate numbers
